


Candidate Profile: Jena Nelson for State Superintendent

Jena has been a friend of mine for years, as well as a source of personal inspiration. A country girl from southeastern Oklahoma, she overcame a difficult childhood in part because a teacher believed in her. She turned her anger and frustration into a determination to overcome, and became a teacher herself. And not just any teacher, a great one. She was named Oklahoma's teacher of the year in 2020. The experience took her out of the classroom and on a journey around Oklahoma and the United States. She learned to look at the larger picture, and while she loves our public schools, some of what she saw alarmed her: a broad attack on public education by special interests who want to profit from the privatization of our education heritage. She also witnessed the effect of the pandemic on schools, schoolchildren and the people who work in our schools. The crisis placed an even heavier burden on schools already weighed down by every social problem, and devastated many students who were cut off from in-person learning and all the things schools do for them. Some blamed the schools themselves for the problems forced on them, often because they never believed in the value of public education in the first place. This only made things worse. After writing dozens of recommendation letters for teachers who were leaving the profession, she decided she had to do something. She filed for candidacy in March because she knew that our system of public education was under attack, and needed a defender.
