Re: Violation of SB 658

To Whom It May Concern OR Dear _____:

As you are aware, Governor Stitt signed SB658 into law (the “Bill”) in May of 2021 and it went into effect July of 2021. The Bill specifies that Schools and universities must notify parents and students that they may opt-out of vaccination mandates using legally allowed exemptions.

The law explicitly states:

*"The State Department of Education shall provide and ensure that each school district in this state provides, **on the school district website and in any notice or publication provided to parents regarding immunization requests, the following information regarding immunization requirements for school attendance:***

“For school enrollment, a parent or guardian shall provide one of the following:

- 1. Current, up-to-date immunization records; or*
- 2. A completed and signed exemption form.”*

It has come to our attention that _____ (School Name) is violating this section of the Bill. We hereby request that you modify your policies to bring them into compliance with the Bill. We also request that this issue be addressed at the next school Board meeting.
