

Vote NO on HB 1755 & SB 1078

Serious Threats to Oklahoma Farmers and American Agriculture

WHAT HB 1755 & SB 1078 REALLY DO

- **Grants Complete Immunity** to foreign pesticide manufacturers Bayer and ChemChina from accountability when they violate federal law and harm Oklahoma farmers private property or health.
- **Strips Farmers Rights—blocking all accountability**, even when evidence shows pesticide companies deliberately hide risks and damage Oklahoma farms.

WHAT HB 1755 & SB 1078 DOES NOT DO:

Facts vs. Myths

- **MYTH:** This bill protects American farmers.
- **FACT: This bill protects German and Chinese chemical companies** that harm Oklahoma farmers.
- **MYTH:** The bill doesn't prevent lawsuits.
- **FACT:** It gives foreign corporations a free pass—blocking ALL lawsuits against pesticide manufacturers for violating FIFRA's labeling law, even when they harm private property.
- **MYTH:** Lawsuits undermine domestic agricultural supply chains and U.S. food security.
- **FACT: Bayer has made over €60 billion selling glyphosate-based products since 2018**—they aren't leaving the market. Even if they did, [Albaugh LLC is the #1 domestic supplier of generic glyphosate](#), where it is made in St. Joseph, MO.

LAWSUITS ARE CRITICAL TO EXPOSING CORPORATE MISCONDUCT

The Dicamba Case Study Shows Why Lawsuits Matter:

- **In 2017, Oklahoma farmers lost thousands of acres of soybeans due to dicamba drift;** nationwide, 3.6 million acres were damaged
- **Court evidence revealed Monsanto/Bayer deliberately hid the risks—stopping relevant testing** on dicamba's drift potential to cover up the risks to neighboring fields
- [Litigation revealed that the company knew dicamba would drift](#)—they expected farmers would be forced into "defensive planting" of dicamba-resistant seeds and grow Monsanto's seed sales.
- **If HB 1755 and SB 1078 had been in place, Oklahoma farmers would be defenseless.**

HB 1755 & SB 1078 do not protect Oklahoma farmers— they **shield foreign chemical corporations from accountability**. These bills:

- **Give Bayer and ChemChina complete immunity—even when they harm private property**
- **Strip Oklahoma farmers of their rights to hold corporations accountable**
- **Protect foreign interests over American farmers and rural communities**

Oklahoma lawmakers should reject this immunity scheme
Stand with American farmers, not foreign chemical corporations
